Regulation

The contest rules of Austrian Aero Club (section hang and paragliding) and FAI Sporting Code Section 7 (www.fai.org/civl-documents) will be applied.

Requirements for Participation

Pilot license, valid FAI sport license, checked paraglider (EN A-D, CCC), valid third-party and rescue insurance, helmet, safety parachute and back protector, paid entry fee, completed and signed registration form. Change of glider during contest can only be allowed by organizer. Gliders must be used in certified configuration which can be checked. Doping is forbidden and local anti-doping rules will be applied.

Registration Process and Fee

Pilots must pre-register at http://www.livetrack24.com until 19th of June, thereby also pay registration fee in advance (club's bank account: IBAN AT43394790000054064). 20 starting slots are reserved for international pilots. First-come-first-serve principle to be follows.

€ 55.- for participants of Alpe-Adria-Cup

From 20th of July onwards, registration is possible on first day of contest in case that free slots are available. Further 5.- Euro will be charged.

If contest is cancelled at all, registration fee minus 5.- Euro will be refunded.

If second task is cancelled one day in advance, 20.- € will be refunded.

Tasks

2 tasks depending on weather (e. g. race to goal, speed run). Ranking will be valid even if only one task can be performed.

Program

1st day -4th of July

9.30 a. m. Official welcome of participants in race office, then pilots'

briefing and departure to take-off

> 11 a. m. Briefing and sign-in at take-off and first task

From 3 p. m. Unofficial meeting of pilots on landing area and party

2nd day – 5th of July

9.30 a. m. Pilots' briefing and departure to take off

> 11 a. m. Briefing and sign-in at take-off and second task

From 3 p. m. Unofficial meeting of pilots on landing area

~ 5 p. m. Award ceremony

Decision about execution

On 3rd of July noon, it will be finally decided if the competition will be executed. Decision will be posted on www.dgfc.at and www.paragleiter.org.

Documentation

Flight documentation only with pilot's GPS device, preferably Flymaster Livetrack.

Classes

- Overall class (EN A-D, CCC)
- Serial class (EN A-D)
- Sport class (EN A-c)
- Women's class (EN A-D, CCC; >= 5 participants)
- Fun & Safety class (EN A-B)

Awards and Prizes

Prize certificates and giveaways

Protest

Free formal objection latest within 30 minutes after posting of provisional ranking.

Official protests only in writing within 30 minutes after posting of final ranking submitted to organizer. Protest fee € 50.-

Protest fee to highest federal flight commission ONF € 100.-

Liabilities regulation

Each pilot participates at own risk and is responsible to comply with Austrian law. Pilots must not make organizer nor any third-party accountable for accidents, injuries or any other incidents.
