Each pilot needs a valid pilot license, a FAI sporting license, a third-party liability insurance valid in Austria, helmet, rescue parachute, a certified harness and a GPS devise for scoring. Only certified gliders are allowed.

The organizer as well as the landowners / owners of the take-off and landing sites assume no liability towards the pilots or third parties. Participation in the competition, transfer, retrieval and supporting program is at your own risk.
